

Countdown to Campus

Below you will find a list of key deadlines you must meet as a new MIT student. Items must be received by MIT or completed online by 5:00 PM US Eastern Daylight Time (EDT) on the date given, unless otherwise specified (for example, the First Year Essay Exam (FEE) is due at 1:00 PM EDT on the respective date).

Be sure to check your MIT email for important communications and reminders we send over the summer. We only send messages to your MIT email account, so see [Getting Started with IT for students](#) for details on accessing your MIT email.

May

- May: Submit your [Medical Report](#) no later than July 1. For questions, see the [Medical Report FAQ](#) or email medrpt@med.mit.edu.
- May: All students MUST complete their vaccinations before September 1, 2025. If you are outside the United States, and one or more of the vaccines are not available in your country, you can get vaccinated at a pharmacy such as CVS or Walgreens when you arrive in the United States. Be sure to ask the pharmacy to give you a copy of your vaccination records. For questions, see the [Medical Report FAQ](#).
- May: Submit your [Emergency Contact Information form](#) on WebSIS no later than August 1. MIT needs to have your emergency information. Please discuss this with your parents or guardians and then fill out both your Personal Emergency Contact information on WebSIS. You will be prompted to update this every semester during Registration.
- May: Submit your Final Transcript and Official Test Scores (SAT, ACT, or English language proficiency exams) for all self-reported exams to the Admissions Office. Log into your [applicant status portal](#) to see instructions on how to submit your Final Transcript and view the status of which items Admissions has received. The scores must be sent through the testing agencies such that the Admissions Office receives them by June 15. If you have already sent official test scores, you do not need to resubmit. Contact the Admissions Office directly at admissions@mit.edu if you have questions about this step or are unable to send your final transcript by July 1, as OFY staff does not process these materials and cannot provide assistance.
- May 5: First Year Academic Information Session Form goes live [here](#). Registration closes on June 2, 2025. A zoom link for your specific session will be sent after registration closes.

- May 9: Deadline to [create your Kerberos Account and create your MIT Email address](#). You will need your 9-digit MIT ID number which can be found in your admission letter. Email servicedesk@mit.edu with any questions.
- May 14: [Housing application](#) opens for the Class of 2029. Housing applications are due on June 4, 2025 at 12:00 PM EDT. Email residence@mit.edu with any questions.
- May 14: Pre-Orientation Program (FPOP) Application goes live [here](#). FPOP applications are due on June 13, 2025. Email fpop@mit.edu with any questions.

Results will be posted in your First Year Online Advising Folder, which goes live on August 15. There is no need to pay for the scores to be rushed to MIT. Email ap@mit.edu with any questions.
- July 11: Deadline for submission of [Transfer Credit materials](#) (Math, Chemistry, and Physics). Request for Transfer Credit Forms must be received for evaluation by this date to guarantee review before the end of summer. Email ap@mit.edu with any questions.
- July 11: Deadline to submit the [Advanced Standing Exam Registration Form](#).
- July 14 – July 21: July First Year Essay Evaluation (FEE). [Essays are due](#) at 1:00 PM EDT on July 21. Email fee-help@mit.edu with any questions.

September

- September 1: Deadline to complete their vaccinations. Advanced Standing Exam Dates:

These are the only dates that these exams will be held. Registration for the Advanced Standing Exams is from June 30 – July 11. ASEs will be held remotely through August 8. Exams on August 25 and September 2 will be in person. You can only sign up for one ASE offering that occurs on the same day in the same time slot, so please plan accordingly.
